



Willenhall Community Primary School
Parent Questionnaire Analysis
July 2017

A questionnaire was distributed to parents to seek their views about a range of issues relating to the school. All parents who sent back their form were placed into a prize draw.

300 questionnaires were sent out to the eldest child and 91 were returned (33 % returned).

Figures in brackets are from last year's survey.
