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Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that your child's school is participating in an enhanced primary mental health service, which will be overseen by Coventry and Warwickshire NHS Partnership Trust. This enhanced offer will involve young people and school staff, it aims to help support the school cultural values, beliefs and practices associated with mental health problems. Students and staff will participate in a variety of activities throughout the academic term that will reduce stigma and increase confidence in seeking and providing appropriate support to those that require it.

As part of this project we are aiming to offer the opportunity for some students to participate in a five week 'Boomerang' programme within school that aims to increase students' emotional and academic resilience. It will be delivered for an hour per week by mental health professionals and selected school staff. There is growing evidence suggesting that increasing emotional wellbeing and resilience in young people leads to positive health outcomes and better academic results. There may also be whole class sessions or individual sessions offered as part of the enhanced service provision.
