FINAL REMINDERS FOR FRANCE 2018

As there are only a three weeks to go before we set off for France, here are some final reminders before we leave on **TUESDAY 12th JUNE 2018**.

- Please ensure your child is at school by **7:30 am on Tuesday morning**. Please report to Class 6A with your case and rucksack.
- Pack a healthy snack and a drink for the coach journey down as your child will not be eating until they get down to the ferry port. Your child will also need a packed lunch for lunch on the ferry. Children entitled to a free school meal will have one ordered for them.
- If your child needs to take any medication, you must make sure a member of staff knows about this (this includes travel sickness). ***Please clearly label any medication with instructions of how often it needs to be taken.*** If your child requires an asthma inhaler they must bring one with them or, by law, we cannot allow them to take part in the trip. Please see me so I can tick you off my list.
- You will be able to contact Ms. Kiely on her mobile (07831304820) only in an **emergency**. We will send you a text informing you when your child has arrived in France.
- We will also send a text to all parents so you know when your child is expected back at school. This ensures that all parents will get the necessary information quickly and avoid Ms. Kiely's phone being bombarded with calls.
- I suggest that your child should bring no more than **£30 (English) and £30 (Euros)**
- **NO mobile phones will be allowed on the trip.**
- Activity and reading books and battery operated MP3 /iPods for coach and ferry journey are allowed.
- We will arrive back at school at around **8:00 pm on Friday 15th June** so please have your mobile phone switched on so that we can confirm the time with you. Please be ready to collect your child on time as they will be extremely tired when they get back and so will the staff!

On the reverse of this letter is the original clothing / item list for the trip for your reference.

Dear Parent/Carer,

Here is a suggested list for your child's trip to St. Omer in France.

- £30 (English) and €30 (Euros) with a money belt/purse (no other currencies please!)
- Small suitcase to hold all the items
- Rucksack for day trips
- Sturdy, comfortable shoes for walking (we will be doing a lot of this.)
- Clothes suitable (old, casual, warm and comfortable) for day trips and outdoor activities around the Chateau
- Underwear, socks, nightwear and slippers
- Lightweight waterproof in case it rains
- Set of smart clothes and shoes for evening disco
- Toiletries (toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, shower gel etc.)
- Towels (1) - 1 for general use.
- High factor sun cream lotion- 30 SPF minimum
- Sun hat or a cap in case it gets hot.
- Any medication if required clearly labelled (inhalers, travel sickness tablets etc.) **Separate forms to be filled in.**
- Plastic bags for those dirty or wet items
- Disposable camera but staff will be taking lots of photos
- Music to listen to, book or activity book for the long journey
- Do not need to bring any bedding
- Plastic refillable water bottle
