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Year 6 Safeguarding Workshop – Helping Hands

Dear Parents / Carers,

On Monday 2nd July, we have invited Loudmouth Education and Training into school for a special presentation to the Year 6 children about how to stay safe.

Loudmouth Education & Training has been creating and running safeguarding programmes for children and young people since 1994. They have worked with over half a million children and young people across the UK and Europe and are a regular part of many schools' annual PSHE programmes.

Helping Hands is a sensitive 'theatre in education' presentation that helps children to stay safe. This well researched and carefully structured session helps children's understanding of many different aspects of safeguarding, learn protective behaviours and where to go for support. The session provides a safe and gentle way to explore 'what is a good or bad relationship?' to introduce concepts of child sexual exploitation (CSE) and domestic abuse (DA).

Issues covered in the programme include:

- What is a good and bad relationship?
- Child Sexual Exploitation
- Domestic Abuse
- Bullying including online bullying
- Protective behaviours / safeguarding
