Our school was recently inspected by OFSTED and we are pleased to inform you that the final OFSTED report is available on www.ofsted.gov.uk and on our school website.

The summary of the key findings is that our school's overall effectiveness is graded as GOOD.

- **Effectiveness of leadership and management is graded as GOOD**
The senior leadership team and governors work well together and they have an accurate understanding of the school's strengths and areas for improvement.
Leaders ensure that pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development and their understanding of British Values is good.
 - **Quality of teaching, learning and assessment is graded as GOOD**
Teachers know the pupils very well. Teaching is good and learning is interesting.
The curriculum is broad and balanced and pupils develop specific knowledge and skills and they enjoy a range of experiences.
Phonics teaching is effective.
 - **Personal development, behaviour and welfare is graded as GOOD**
Behaviour across the school is good. Pupils are polite and well-mannered, considerate and show respect to one another.
Pastoral support for pupils who have special educational needs and/or disabilities helps them to become confident in school.
 - **Outcomes for pupils is graded as REQUIRES IMPROVEMENT**
Leaders have made the necessary changes that were needed to stem the decline in the school's performance over the last two years.
- The judgement for outcomes was based on Key Stage 2 SATS results from 2017. This year's SATs results have been published this week and we are proud to announce that there is a huge improvement in all subjects. Details are on our school website.
- **Early Years provision is graded as GOOD**
